ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAULLINA, IOWA 2016, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS DISCHARGE DATES.

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Paullina, Iowa:

SECTION 1. TITLE III, – PUBLIC ORDER PROTECTION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT, CHAPTER 1 – MISDEMEANORS, ARTICLE 4 –PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, SECTION 4.01.3 – Fireworks Discharging General Requirements, Letter E. is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) <u>Remove</u> June 1 thru July 9 from the hours of 9 am thru 10 pm. Exception: discharge hours are extended to 11 pm on July 4th only. Between the hours of 9am and 11 pm on Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding and following December 31.
- 2) <u>Remove</u> entire section.

Replace with

 The Monday before the last Saturday in June thru July 4 from the hours of 9 am until 10 pm. Exception: discharge hours are extended to 11 pm on July 4th only.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be judged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
