

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAULLINA, IOWA, 2016 BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Paullina, Iowa:

TITLE II, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, SECTION 6.02 – “Rental Rates” is amended by changing the rates as follows:

RENTAL RATES

<u>Water Used</u>	<u>Sewer Service Charge</u>
First 1,000 gallons or lessor Amount per month	\$12.00 per month (minimum monthly bill)
2,000- 15,000 gallons	\$6.00 per 1,000 gallons per month
16,000+	\$3.00 per 1,000 gallons per month

In no case shall the minimum service charge be less than \$12.00 per month, which is necessary to retire indebtedness, operating and maintenance, and reserve necessary for maintaining the sanitary sewer facility.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be judged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3: WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
