

CITY OF PAULLINA ORDINANCE REMINDERS

AS THE WARMER MONTHS ROLL IN, MAKE SURE YOU ARE UP TO DATE ON ALL CITY OF PAULLINA ORDINANCES

CAT ORDINANCES

- Cats <u>are not</u> allowed to run at large.
- Please do not feed stray cats! (Cats that do not live in your home)

DOG ORDINANCES

- Be sure you are up to date on what consists of a dog being deemed vicious per Paullina City Code.
- If an animal is left unattended outside, the animal needs to have a restraint to prevent the animal from leaving the premises.
 - Any person owning/caring for an animal must keep the property in a clean and sanitary condition.
- Any person who permits a pet on another property must immediately remove any waste excreted by the animal.
 A dog who barks excessively will be considered a bothersome animal which is against ordinance.

Lawn Care

- Maintain lawn to 8 inches in height or less
- Yard waste is not permitted to be thrown in residential/commercial garbage for pickup
- The City offers a tree dump where sticks/leaves/yard waste can be dumped at no charge. No construction or solid waste is allowed in this area.

DOMESTIC ANIMALS ORDINANCES

- Each residence cannot have more than 5 domestic animals older than 3 months
- Domestic animals are not allowed to run at-large
- Please always clean up after your pets on your property and especially on others' property!



REMINDER FOR ALL RESIDENTS:
