

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAULLINA, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL.

Be it Enacted by the City Council of the City of Paullina, Iowa:

SECTION 1. TITLE II–PUBLIC SERVICE AND PUBLIC HEALTH, CHAPTER 1: SOLID WASTE CONTROL, ARTICLE 2–COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF SOLID WASTE 2.12 “COLLECTION FEES/UNIT BASED PRICING” subparagraph 1 is hereby amended as follows:

- 2.12 1a. For each single-family dwelling and each dwelling unit on residential premises, there will be a minimum fee of \$15.00 per month. This includes all residential premises located in the restricted residence zoning district in the City of Paullina and other family dwelling units located outside the restricted residence district.
- b. The minimum fee identified above for family dwellings and dwelling units shall cover the collection of one (1) sixty-five (65) gallon garbage cart weighing not more than 75 (seventy-five) pounds per week. Said garbage cart shall be provided by the City of Paullina.
- c. For each commercial, industrial, and institutional premises using a blue cart provided by the City of Paullina, the minimum fee shall be \$15.00 per month. For commercial, industrial, and institutional premises with a dumpster, the fee shall be \$5.60 per cubic yard, with a minimum monthly fee of \$33.50.
- d. The City Council may adjust the fee imposed and to be collected upon a showing by written application filed with the City Clerk that there are unusual or extraordinary circumstances which warrant a change in the fee imposed. Furthermore, the Council may by resolution set a fee higher or lower than stated above for extraordinary circumstances.
- e. Adjustments may be made by the Council for vacancy when a resident moves to assisted living, a nursing home, or other facility with no intent of returning to the premises. No adjustments shall be made by the Council for vacancies due to vacations whether during the summer or winter or other temporary vacancies of the property.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be judged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
